Towards a new Tuscan regional law on communication,
information and discipline of Corecom

Firenze, 29 June 2018

The Tuscan regional law regulating information, communication and Corecom is n. 22 of 25 June 2002. The context in which that law was approved has changed profoundly over the past 16 years, and the communication field has seen the emergence of means, techniques, languages, needs that today give us a completely new overall picture. The Corecom Toscana, considering a revision of the law 22/2002 no longer to be postponed, has decided to start a process of reflection and comparison at the regional, national and European levels to propose a new text that takes into account the challenges facing the Regions in communication matters.

The first scheduled appointment is the conference "Responding to an Evolving Communications Environment", organised by the Corecom Toscana in collaboration with the Regional Council of Tuscany, the Italian Communications Authority, Corecom National Coordination, the Center for Media Pluralism and Media Freedom at European University Institute. Friday, June 29, at the Chapel of Villa Schifanoia, EUI in Fiesole, we will start to discuss with academics, legislators, institutions and representatives of other European regional authorities.
